#### DANGERS FOR HUMANS AND ENVIRNOMENT











- High temperature in the GC oven, the jet port of the flame ionisation detector (FID) and the transfer line (connected to mass spectrometry).
- The capillary can easily break if it is adjusted or cut.
- Sharp and fast-moving needle of the syringe of the automatic sample feeder.
- High pressure possible in liquid nitrogen tank. Monitor pressure relief valve for proper operation.
- High voltage applied to open cables.
- Gases, such as highly explosive mixtures of hydrogen and large amounts of nitrogen.
- Use of volatile components.

#### PROTECTIVE MEASURES AND RULES OF CONDUCT







- As long as the system is running, do not touch the FID part, the transmission line or the interface to the GC.
- When handling the capillary, protection such as wearing goggles, gloves and a lab coat is necessary. The splitting stone for cutting capillaries must be held securely because of its sharpness.
- While the autosampler is taking samples from the vials, the needle of the syringe must not be touched under any circumstances.
- While filling, installing or checking the liquid nitrogen tank, protective goggles, cold gloves and a lab coat must be worn.
- It is not allowed to touch electrical lines without disconnecting them from the voltage.
- Check the safety instructions in the safety manual before using gases such as hydrogen, nitrogen or helium.
- Before using chemicals, especially volatile or toxic compounds, check the safety regulations of chemical register systems such as Damaris, or the GESTIS substance database.
