<p><b>Arrival Information</b></p>	<p>Getting to Duisburg from Duesseldorf International airport (DUS):  With public transportation, you can reach Duisburg within 15- 20 minutes from the Duesseldorf airport terminal (skytrain and then S-Bahn or RE train to Duisburg mainstation).</p> <p>From Duisburg Hbf (mainstation) it takes 10 minutes by bus to Campus Duisburg (Bus no. 933, 924, 926)</p>
